New Business &	& Pulled Reports		
DEI	Lissa Parker – See submitted report, includes information from western zone meeting and USA Swimming legislation that will be brought forward in the business meeting. They would like to host a DEI camp in Indianapolis during trials; the western LSC's would send 2 athletes, the DEI chair, and another adult to the summit that is also going to occur. The requirements will most likely be an AA standard; selection of athletes will occur in late January or early February. USA Swimming would like us to commit, or not, as an LSC so further arrangements can be made. The proposal will be coming. For our Oregon select camp this Fall in Lake Oswego, September 16 <sup>th</sup> works for Emily. Lissa would like to finalize the curriculum and qualifications this week. Rex Watkins – Pulled from Lissa's report, asking about the parallel time standards for disabled athletes mentioned. We do not currently have any. Emily Melina – They talked about having time standards for AGZ, that could be a place for us to start and derive our standards from there. Sheila Lovell-Otterstrom – Recommended Micah Masei as a potential athlete to reach out to for the Mini-Expo if Arena does not have one for us. Debbie Laderoute – Should have the information by the end of this week about athletes and pool space. Lissa Parker - Makes a proposal that OSI supports sending 2 DEI athletes and two representatives from OSI to the DEI camp being held at trials next year. Shelly Rawding – Second DEI proposal passed.		
Lifetime Fitness	Debbie Laderout – There is a new swim team at a new facility in the Beaverton area up that has submitted all of their paperwork and would like to start on September 1, 2023. Their name would be Lifetime Oregon Swim Club, with club code LIFE.		

Travel Reimbursement	<ul> <li>Shelly Rawding - makes a motion that we approve the new Beaverton team with LIFE as their club code.</li> <li>Sheila Lovell-Otterstrom – second Approved</li> <li>Emily Melina – We approved a 35% increase for travel reimbursements in our budget; in our P&amp;P, we only approved it for the first year in 2022. We have already budgeted for the increase, but would need to extend it to our P&amp;P. Emily is proposing that we change our P&amp;P, the numbers in the table, to include the 35% increase for travel reimbursements for this year as well, which is aligned with what we have budgeted, with the understanding a further revamp coming.</li> <li>Rex Watkins – Makes it a motion.</li> <li>Jack Burnett – Second.</li> <li>Motion approved.</li> </ul>	
Outreach Athlete Meet Offsets	Emily Melina – A proposal athletes who qualify for Outreach memberships as defined by OSI are eligible to receive additional support for swim meet fees (includes event fees, but not FUF/athlete surcharge), please see the submitted report for more information. With the increased Championship meet fees, this will help support our highest need members and ensure they are able to attend championship meets, while still making sure our host clubs and LSC are able host the events at the level we expect. Currently we have 112 registered outreach athletes. This past year, none attended Futures or higher. The impact financially is likely minimal overall, but the impact to these athletes could be significant. It would most likely come out of the travel fund. Emily would like to put this is effect for this upcoming Fall. Rhonda Soule – Deserves a new line item on the budget, as a new expense; will still go under the travel fund category. Will be hard to predict what the actual amount will be. Jack Burnett makes a motion to approve the proposal for a year with minor corrections. Shelly Rawding second. Motion approved	
Champs Meet Proposal	Rick Guenther – Has a format suggestion for 11 and Over LC Champs that would make it all four days for all swimmers, including 11-12-year-olds, as well as separate out the 11-12 from the 13 and overs during prelims (how events are swam during finals). The 50's are swum on different days that the 200's. Thursday: 11-12 200IM, 13&O 200IM, 11-12 50FR, 13&O 50FR, 11-12 50Fly, 11&O 200BR, 11&O 800FR. Friday: 11&O 200BK, 11-12 100FR, 13&O 100FR, 11-12 100Fly, 13&O 11Fly, 11-12 50BR, 15&O Girls 400IM, 15&O Boys 400FR, 11-14 Girls 400IM, 11-14 Boy 400FR. Saturday: 400 FR Relays (11-12, 13-14, 15&O), 11-12 50BK, 11&O 200Fly, 11-12 100BR, 13&O 100BR, 15&O Girls 400FR, 15&O Boys 400IM, 11-14 Girls 400FR, 11-14 Boy 400IM. • Jim Peterfish, chair of the National Disability Subcommittee, spoke during the meeting about proposed legislation R-5 to modify Article 105 which provides guidelines for officiating swimmers with disabilities. I feel this is a really good re-write of Article 5 and I hope you and your LSC delegates at the USA Swimming annual business meeting will support R-5.
