



Trainer Requirements

Certification requirements and endorsements must be submitted to the master trainer prior to attending clinic.

Electronic Timing

- Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 12 sessions, 6 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.
- Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned or observed/approved meets. High school and college dual meets do not apply.
- Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.
- Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or Electronic Timing Chair and/or at least 2 other ET trainers.
- Attend Train the Trainer clinic.
- Attend Electronic Timer clinic as an observer after attending Train the Trainer clinic.

Administrative Official

- Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 1 year and 20 sessions as AO or ET, or a current ET trainer and worked 10 sessions as AO.
- Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned or observed/approved meets. High school and college dual meets do not apply.
- Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.
- Resume of 3 meets set up and run in meet manager submitted to Administrative Official Chair.
- Endorsement from Administrative Official Chair or 2 endorsements from some combination of current AO trainers and referees.
- Attend Train the Trainer clinic.
- Attend Administrative Official clinic as an observer after attending Train the Trainer clinic.
- To also be an ET trainer must meet all ET trainer requirements.

Stroke and Turn

- Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 12 sessions, 6 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.
- Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned or observed/approved meets. High school and college dual meets do not apply.
- Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.
- Endorsements from Area Officials Chair or one referee.
- Attend Train the Trainer clinic.
- Attend Stroke and Turn Clinic as an observer after attending Train the Trainer clinic.

Starter

- Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 1 year and 20 sessions, 10 of which must be at a meet heavy in BC swimmers.
- Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned or observed/approved meets. High school and college dual meets do not apply.
- Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.
- Endorsements from a member of the Officials Committee.
- Must be a Stroke and Turn Trainer.
- Attend Starter clinic as an observer after attending Train the Trainer clinic.



Trainer Requirements

Deck Referee

- Certified and worked in that position a minimum of 20 sessions. Meet referee, deck referee, and administrative referee positions apply.
- Sessions worked must be at OSI sanctioned or observed/approved meets. High school and college dual meets do not apply.
- Must have consistently worked at more than one pool.
- Endorsement from Area Officials Chair or OSI Officials Chair and one referee.
- Must be a Stroke and Turn and Starter trainer.
- Attend Referee Clinic as an observer after attending Train the Trainer clinic.

(Deck Referee Trainers may not provide final evaluations to Referee Trainees or present Referee Training clinics.)

Referee Evaluator and Clinic Presenter

- Meet all requirements of Deck Referee Trainer
- Member of Oregon Swimming Officials Committee

Master Trainer

- Certified as a trainer a minimum of 1 year
- Endorsement from the OSI Officials Chair
- Observe a Trainer the Trainer clinic
- Present a Train the Trainer clinic with a master trainer observing
- Must completely understand the Train the Trainer materials and how to certify for all positions
