From Portland: Head Westbound on HWY 26 to HWY 6. HWY 6 to Banks Exit, Head South on HWY 47, stay on **Directions:**

HWY 47 to Sunset Drive. Take a right on Sunset Drive. The pool is on the West side of Sunset Drive.

Indoor, 25 yd. pool with six lanes, non-turbulence lane lines and overflow gutters. All events will have a Facility:

> 5 ½ ft. starting depth and is 11 ft. on the turns. Adaptive access is by ladders at both ends of the pool. Open pool deck areas, specifically marked on the day of the meet are available for swimmers, coaches and officials only. The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Daktronics timing system, horn start, finish touch-pads and dual button backup and Keifer Intrepid

starting blocks. Results via Daktronics display board.

The shallow end of the competition pool will be available Friday, Saturday PM and Sunday PM sessions for warm up and cool down purposes only. **The small pool and hot tub will be CLOSED.**

Parking:

Parking is available. There is no camping or RV parking. Limited off-street parking is available at the pool and on the east and north sides of Pacific University's Sports Complex. On street parking is available east of Sunset Drive on side streets and at Gray & Company parking lot off of 23rd, one block east of the pool.

Entry Details:

Swimmers may enter a maximum of one individual event on Friday, and six individual events for Saturday and Sunday sessions combined, with no more than four individual events on any day, excluding one relay entry per day. Entries will be limited to a maximum of 325 swimmers.

Positive check in will be required for All individual events 400 yards and over. Check in deadline will be the start of the warm-up period for that session. Positive check in will be located at Clerk of Course.

Entries will be accepted starting at 9:00 AM, FRIDAY November 10th, 2023 and in order of submission until such time as the session/meet is full or the entry deadline is reached. Submit yard times only for seeding. Submit entries on Hy-Tek software by email. With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.

ALL Entries must be received before 6:00 PM Friday November 17th^h, **2023** A check made out to Forest Grove Swim Club for the full amount of the entry & event fees will be accepted **in hand no later than DEC 09, 2023.** If you wish to send payment via mail, please Send to: FGSC Attn: Meet Director, P.O. A 4-hour limit per day will be observed and planned from the beginning to the end of all 12 and under sessions. At the Meet Referee's discretion, breaks may be inserted in the meet to provide adequate recovery for athletes between events or for any other reason the Referee sees fit to address.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement." (Section 202.4.9D)

Relays:

If any changes occur with relay names, please submit an updated relay slip at the clerk of course before warm-ups.

Daktronics timing system, horn start, and finish touch pads with dual button backup. Keifer Intrepid starting blocks. Results via electronic scoreboard. This is a timed finals meet. This is an INVITATIONAL meet.

Bullpen:

Awards:

Ribbons will be given to the top six finishers and top three relay finishers in each individual event by age group & gender. Heat winners will receive their award at the end of each heat

Scoring will be based on twelve individual places (16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1) in each of the following age groups: 8 & under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over, for each event and six places

Scoring:

(14-10-8-6-4-2) in relay events. Only "A" relays will be scored.

Meetings:

Coaches meetings will be held 15 minutes prior to the start of the meet on Friday and both Saturday sessions. Subsequent coaches meetings will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

Officials meetings will be held 1 hour prior to the start time.

Rules:

Current USA Swimming and OSI Rules will govern. OSI Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be strictly enforced.

The following scratch rules will apply:

- 1. For deck seeded events, coaches are responsible for providing positive check-in of swimmers no later than the start of warm-ups for that session on Friday, Saturday AM/PM and Sunday AM/PM. Positive Check in is located at Clerk of course.
- 2. After the heats have been seeded, all positive check-in swimmers who fail to compete in an individual event will be barred from his/her next individual event.

Exceptions for failure to compete: No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if:

- 1. The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof.
- 2. It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.

Restrictions:

No technical suit may be worn by any 12 & under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved or observed meet. No tobacco products, alcohol, or glass containers are allowed in the facility. Shaving is not allowed in the venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator

areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are

No Coach:

For unattached swimmers, or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer's responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done <u>BEFORE</u> the swimmer can enter the water for warm-ups or competition. Upon arrival at the meet, please see the Meet Director or the Meet Referee if assistance is needed.

Safety:

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Unaccompanied swimmers must be assigned a coach BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition.
