SHALL BE PERMITTED. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of June 21, 2024. **Meet limited to 250 swimmers.**

Entry Deadline: Entries May begin being submitted on June 8th, 2024. Entries must be received by 5:00 pm, Wednesday, June 19, 2024

Entry Limit: No swimmers may compete in more than three (3) individual events and one (1) relay per day and seven (7) individual and two (2) relays for a meet.

Entry Fees: \$3.00 Oregon Swimming surcharge per swimmer

\$3.75 individual event fee \$12.00 relay entry fee

Entries: With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming. Submit short course METER TIMES ONLY for seeding. Swimmers will be pre-seeded. No time (NT) entries will be seeded last. Submit entries via HY-TEK meet management software formatted file. Please contact meet referee on adaptive simmers. Lentries must include swimmers name, age, and USA Swimming number. All E-mailed entries must be received no later than Wednesday, June 19, 2024. There will be no late entries or scratches after this date. Scratches of a swimmer may be accepted up to the start of each day session.

RELAY ENTRIES: Relay entries for Saturday are due to the office at 8:00 a.m.

Relay entries for Sunday are due to the office at 8:00 a.m.

Scratches: Scratches for Saturday are due to the office by 8:00 a.m.

No Coach Present: For unattached swimmers or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmers responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done **BEFORE** the swimmer may enter the water for warmups or competition. Please see the Meet Director or the Meet Referee if assistance is needed, upon arrival at the meet.

Facility: Outdoor, 25 meter X six (6) lanes with dividers. Starting blocks at the deep end of the pool only (9 ft.).

Shallow end is 3'6". The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Relay legs starting from the shallow end will be in the water starts.

Bleachers are available for spectators. Parking available next to the pool. Snack bar will be open throughout the meet. Swim venue includes: Men's and Women's locker rooms with access onto the pool deck; Open pool deck areas available for swimmers, coaches and officials only. Swimmers not swimming may be in their team area on the pool deck, along the park side of the pool. Facility is accessible to adaptive swimmers participating in an event.

Restrictions: NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES and GLASS

CONTAINERS ALLOWED ON DECK, IN DRESSING ROOMS, POOL AREA AND BLEACHERS. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Cell phones or other recording devices are not allowed behind the blocks. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Rules: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming Inc., rules will govern this meet. COACHES ARE REQUIRED TO SHOW OREGON SWIMMING CERTIFICATION TO THE MEET DIRECTOR WHEN RECEIVING A COACHES PACKET FOR THE MEET. Tech Suits Statement: No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming

athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

Safety: OREGON SWIMMING SAFETY GUIDELINES WILL BE IN EFFECT AND ENFORCED. VIOLATIONS MAY RESULT IN SWIMMER DISQUALIFICATION FROM MEET. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. WE WILL HAVE A SAFE MEET AND APPRECIATE YOUR COOPERATION!!! All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
