- 3. Athletes must apply their mask immediately after exiting the pool at the conclusion of their heat.

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for the protection of all visitors to the Willamalane Park Swim Center. All posted, written, and other instructions must be followed while visiting the facility. At the discretion of Oregon Swimming, the meet referee, and the facility, COVID-19 restrictions may be adjusted to align with state, county, local, and facility requirements. Directions: Take I-5 to Springfield-Eugene, Take Hwy 126 (Exit 194A). Heading East. Take Mohawk Blvd exit.

Turn Right Onto Mohawk Blvd, turn right on G street. Pool is on the right.

Facility:

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Indoor, 250 yard pool with 8 lanes (7 feet per lane). Starting blocks at the shallow end of the pool (5'6"). Deep end is 6'0". Parking lot and on-street parking is available. Pool deck areas available for swimmers, coaches, and officials only. Spectator access to facility TBD. Pre-designated timers, and 2 representatives of each team (to act as team managers) will be allowed deck access. Concessions available. Facility is accessible to adaptive swimmers.

Restrictions:

Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue, on the grounds, or in the parking areas. There is no shaving allowed in the swimming venue. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Photography of any kind is prohibited behind the blocks. Deck changing is prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Deck Access:

Coaches must display their current USA Swimming membership status at all times while on deck.

Rules:

Current USA Swimming and OSI Rules will govern. OSI Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be strictly enforced.

Format:

This is a timed finals meet.

MAAPP:

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Eligibility:

Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming/Oregon Swimming. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet is applicable to the entire meet. Qualifying times must have been achieved from December 1, 2020 thru the entry deadline. If the qualifying time is not achieved by the athlete during the event at the meet, and proof of a qualifying time is not in the USA SWIMS Database, appropriate proof of the qualifying time must be forwarded to the OSI office within 10 days after the notification from the office. Failure to prove a qualifying time will result in a \$100 non qualifying fine from OSI. There is no on-deck registration.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water.

Schedule:

Saturday warm-ups: 12 noon to 1:15 pm. Timed Finals begin at 1:30 pm. Sunday warm-ups: 8:30 am -9:45 am. Timed finals begin at 10:00 am.

There will be one lane designated for 8 and under swimmers only during the entire warm up period.

Facility will open 15 minutes prior to the start of warm-ups.

Timelines may be adjusted at the discretion of OSI and the Meet Referee. Breaks may be added at the discretion of OSI and the Meet Referee.

Entry Limits: Athletes may enter six individual entries for the meet, but not more than five individual events per day, and 2 relays for the meet.

Entry

Deadline: Entries must be received by Noon on Wednesday, February 9, 2022. No late entries will be accepted.

Entries:

Teams with Hy-Tek or Team Unify should email an entry file and a PDF of the meet entry report to OSI. The office will confirm receipt of entries by replying with two documents: a team entry report and a team fee report. Please verify the amount owed on the team fee report returned by the office. Please do not send a check payment, teams will be invoiced through their team account with OSI. No payments

will be accepted at the facility. Enter personal best times achieved in the qualifying period. Seeding is Short Course Yards (SCY), Short Course Meters (SCM), and then Long Course Meters (LCM). Converted time not accepted. Non-qualifying times and late entries will not be accepted. New qualifying times achieved between February 9 and February 13th, 2022 will be accepted until noon on Monday February 14, 2022. Send an email containing the swimmer's name, USA Swimming ID number, event, and entry time to debbie@oregonswimming.org. Previously entered times will not be updated. Received emails will be acknowledged by 1:30 pm on Monday.

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter the meet. If accommodations are required, it is the coach's responsibility to notify the Meet Director and Meet Referee prior to the entry deadline. If the meet has time standards, contact the Disability Chair for the appropriate time standard to be used.

All Team or individual members, entering OSI Championship meets must be in good standing with no outstanding money owed to Oregon Swimming. All payments must be made prior to the meet entry deadline. *Any Team or member who is not in good standing may be denied entry into Championship meets.*

Relays: "Relay only" swimmers must be entered in the meet and must pay the swimmer surcharge.

Bull Pen: There will be a bullpen for 8&U individual events only. All other swimmers report directly to their assigned

lanes.

Entry Fees: \$15 surcharge per swimmer

\$3 electronic heat sheet fee per swimmer

\$4 per individual event. \$10 per relay event.
