## **Facility**

The outdoor competition pool is 50 meters by 25 yards, 8 lanes, 2.5 meters per lane; the start end of the competition course is 16.0 feet deep; the turn end of the pool is 6.0 feet deep. Electronic timing and matrix scoreboard systems will be used. Facilities are accessible for swimmers with disabilities and they are encouraged to participate. The facility will ensure that the stated measurements are accurate.

## Rules

Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming rules will govern this meet. All walkways around the pool and lifeguard stations must be kept clear. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate ejection from the meet and premises. No tech suit may be worn by any 12 and under USA swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved or observed meet. Tobacco, non tobacco, vape products of any kind, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. No shaving permitted. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, are not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or lockers rooms. Cell phones or other recording devices are not allowed behind the blocks at any time during the meet. Operations of drones or any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue. No deck changing.

## **Eligibility**

Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. No on-deck registration will be permitted. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets the first day of the meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or

must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

### **Format**

**Decathlon** 10 events total for 13 & Over athletes, 5 events per day. **Sextathlon** 6 events total for 12 & Under athletes, 3 events per day.

Athletes must meet the time standard below.

800 free time (11:58.69) 400 free (6:35.59) 400 IM (6:46.89) all 200 events (4:00) NT's will not be accepted.

All events will be swum mixed, slowest to fastest. Meet format will be LCM, timed finals. All events will be pre-seeded. Events 5 and 13 will conclude within 4 hours to adhere to the 12 and under 4 hour rule.

Entries open May 1st, 2024 at 12:01 PM and must be received by

May 17th, 2024 at 5:00 PM; this meet may fill prior to the entry deadline. Late entries may be accepted on a case-by-case basis, contact the meet referee.

Entries will open 12:01 AM on May 1st, 2024.

Entries must be received no later than 5:00 PM on May 17th, 2024.
