ELIGIBILITY:	Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. No on deck meet registration will be permitted. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of the first day of the meet.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES:	Swimmers with disabilities are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.					
ENTRIES:	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Submit YARD TIMES ONLY for seeding. NTs are permitted. Submit entries via E-mail in a Hy-Tek formatted file. Please mail entry fees and a printout of Hy-Tek entries. Late entries will be accepted on a space available basis With submission of entries the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.					
ENTRY DEADLINE:	Entries will be accepted starting February 19th at 10:00 AM . Entries must be received no later than 11:59 PM on March 11th . Entry Time updates will be accepted until 11:59 PM March 11th .					
ENTRY LIMIT:	Limit of 3 individual events and 1 relay per session. The Meet Director and Meet Referee may limit entries in any event or eliminate events in order to stay within a reasonable time limit.

NO COACH	For unattached swimmers or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer's					
PRESENT:	responsibility to arrange for a certified coach to be responsible for the swimmer. This must be done BEFORE the swimmer may enter the water for warm-ups or competition. Please see the Meet Director or the Meet Referee if assistance is needed upon arrival at the meet.					
WARM-UP:	Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures are in effect at this meet. Warm-ups are subject to the following procedures: • For warm-ups before the meet both pools will be available. The small pool will also be available through the meet for warm-up and cool down. Note: Swimmers violating safety procedures may be removed from the warm-up for the remainder of the warm-up session. Subsequent violations may cause the swimmer to be removed from the remainder of the meet.

TIMELINE:	The Meet Director reserves the right to change warm-up times as approved by the Referee. All coaches will be informed of any changes to warm-up and competition times. The Meet Referee reserves the right to remove or lengthen breaks written in the sanction as deemed appropriate for the success of the athletes. Timelines are for reference only and the meet may be running ahead or behind the timeline. Swimmers are responsible for getting to their heat in time for the start. Entries will be limited to adhere to the 4 hour rule. Breaks may be added at the discretion of the meet referee. For individual events 200 yards and longer, heats may be limited to adhere to the 4 hour rule. Limits will be based on the order in which entries are received.					







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HEAT SHEETS:	Heat sheets with timelines will be available on the TEAM website in the 'Events' section prior to the meet.			
MEETINGS:	Officials meetings will be held 45 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches meetings will be held 10 min prior to the start of the session.			
TIMERS:	The meet will be run with two manual watches and buttons per lane in addition to a fully automated timing system.			
RULES:	Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. All walkways around the pool and lifeguard stations must be kept clear. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual. Oregon Scratch Rules will not be enforced for this meet.			
FORMAT:	Each session will be timed finals with the exception being the 25 Freestyle. The 25 Freestyle will be Open and a Prelims/Semis/Finals event. Prelims will include all swimmers. The top 16 boys and girls after Prelims will move on to Semis. Semis will be circle seeded. For Finals the top 8 boy and girl swimmers from Semis will compete. All events will be pre-seeded slow to fast. Coaches are encouraged to report scratches.			
AWARDS AND SCORING:	Ribbons and standard scoring for 1-12th separated by age group and gender 8&U, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14. The exception will be the 25 Free. The top 12 swimmers will score and receive ribbons.			
RESTRICTIONS:	No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet. Tobacco, non-tobacco, vapor products of any kind, alcoholic beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue. NO SHAVING PERMITTED. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. Please change in designated changing areas or locker rooms only. No cameras or other recording devices allowed behind the blocks at any time during the meet. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and openceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.			
SAFETY:	Oregon Swimming Safety Rules and Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Medical supervision will be provided by facility lifeguards.
