BE PERMITTED. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of the first day of the meet.

Entry Deadline: Entry acceptance period begins Monday, June 19th, 2024 at NOON. No early entries please - they

Meet Limit: Athlete number will be limited by the 12 & UNDER 4-hour timeline rule.

Entry Limit: Each swimmer is limited to 4 individual events and 1 relay per day.

Entries:

- 1. Submit yard times only for seeding. This is an A/B/C meet. No time standards are applicable.
- 2. Meet Manager/Hy-Tek software will be used. Please submit entries on a Hy/-Tek software formatted disk and entry summary.
- 3. With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.
- 4. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts of must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member/coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with the requirement.

Check-in:

All events will be pre-seeded. Coaches need to inform the meet referee of any scratches prior to warmups of each session.

Events:

All events are timed finals. Swimmers must provide their own timers and lap counters for the 500 Free and longer races.

Facility:

25 yard OUTDOOR pool; six 7-foot lanes; non-turbulent lane lines; 4½ foot entry depth; diving pool for warm-up and cool-down. The depth for the starting on 2nd and 4th relay swimmers will be 3'3", requiring in-the-pool starts for 100 yard relays.

THE COMPETITION COURSE HAS NOT BEEN CERTIFIED IN ACCORDANCE WITH 104.2.2C(4).

Rules:

Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet. Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect and strictly enforced.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

The Roseburg Y Swim Team is held responsible for the UCC facility. Please keep your swimmers in the pool area. All other buildings are off limits. **UCC policy requires that all pets be restricted to the parking lot and the walking trails to the river (west of the pool). No camping allowed on the UCC grounds**. No playing of radios will be allowed in the upper deck or pool area. No alcohol, glass containers, or tobacco products will be allowed. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Photography is not allowed behind the blocks during starts and relay exchanges. Deck changing is prohibited. Operations of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pool, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Time Schedules:

Saturday and Sunday Sessions

Warm-ups: 10:00-11:00 AM (RYST only 9:00-10:00AM)

Timed Finals: 11:15 AM

Breaks will be inserted at discretion of referee as time permits.

Bullpen:

There will be a bullpen for all 8&U individual events. There will be NO bullpen for relays.

Awards:

Ribbons for 1st through 12th place in each individual event; all event places

determined separately (6&U, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15&O). Relay events: Ribbons for 1st through 3rd place. Heat winners will be awarded.

Meetings: Coaches' meeting will be held 15 minutes prior to the start of timed finals. Officials' meeting will be held

at 10:30AM Saturday and Sunday.

Officials: We always appreciate the help of certified officials from other clubs. If you will be attending the meet,

please notify the meet referee.

Timers: Each team will be given timing assignments. Please designate a team representative to report to the

Head Timer 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. The 1650 & 500 must provide two timers and a

lap counter.

Hospitality: Hot and cold drinks and snacks will be provided to deck officials, timers, and coaches. Snacks, as well

as breakfast and lunch, will be provided to deck officials and coaches in the hospitality room.

Concessions: A concession stand will be operating during the entire meet. Please eat and drink in the upper level

only. A food truck will be onsite each day for hot food options.

Lodging: Both motels and camping facilities are located within a 6-mile radius of the pool.

Safety: Oregon swimming Safety Rules and Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse

Prevention Policy ("MAAP"), will govern this meet.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

Medical: The Facility will provide medical supervision to athletes in the form of certified lifeguards.

Restrictions: TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND GLASS CONTAINERS ARE

NOT ALLOWED IN THE SWIMMING VENUE. NO SHAVING. USE OF AUDIO OR VISUAL

RECORDING DEVICES, INCLUDING A CELL PHONE, IS NOT PERMITTED IN CHANGING AREAS, RESTROOMS OR LOCKERROOMS. Deck changing is prohibited. Use of audio visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not allowed behind the blocks. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Deck changing is prohibited. No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 & Under USA Swimming athlete member in

competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

Covid Protocols & Restrictions::

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for the protection of all visitors to Umpqua Community College pool. All posted, written, and other instructions must be followed while visiting the facility. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.
