| Facility: | Outdoor 50 meter, 8 lane 8' per lane with single lane dividers. Colorado Electronic Timing System with touch pads at start end and buttons used on turn end for 50 's finish. Pool depth varies from $6^{\prime} 77^{\prime \prime}$ to $12^{\prime}$ at deep end and $3^{\prime} 6$ ' at shallow end. Facility has steps for adaptive swimmers. The pool does not have a ramp. The facility or host will assure that the measurements are accurate. |
| Restrictions: | TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES and GLASS CONTAINERS ARE NOT ALLOWED in the swimming venue, on the grounds, or in the parking areas. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck changing is prohibited. |

The use of a "Go Pro" and similar photographic or video devices is not allowed in, over, or near the pool during competition. All swimmers entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts, or the swimmer must start each race from within the water.

No Coach: For unattached swimmers or swimmers whose coach is not attending the meet, it is the swimmer's responsibility to arrange for a certified coach before the swimmer enters the water for warm-ups or competition.

4 Hour Rule: This meet is planned such that events for 12 \& Under swimmers can reasonably be concluded within four (4) hours. The number of entered events will be reduced for all athletes should the 4 hour limit for 12 \& U's be exceeded based on entries received.

Tech Suits: USA Swimming Rule 102.8.1F - No Technical Suit may be worn by any 12 \& Under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any Sanctioned, Approved or Observed meet.

Medical: Medical facilities available include club staff, lifeguards and access to first responders via 911.

Warm-ups: All teams will be assigned to warm-up lanes for the entire warm-up period. Coaches are encouraged to schedule more experienced swimmers for the first half of the period and less experienced swimmers for the second half of the period.

Eligibility: Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. Swimmers must be within entered age brackets as of June 21, 2024. This is an age group, $A / B / C$ invitational meet.

Entry Deadline: Entries open June 4, 2024, noon. Entries close no later than 5:00 pm, Tuesday, June 11, 2024.

Entry Limit: This is a split format, 10 \& Under, 11 \& Over meet. Swimmers may enter a maximum of two (2) individual events plus one relay on Friday night. Swimmers may enter a maximum of three (3) individual events plus one relay on each of Saturday and Sunday.

Meet Format: All events will be pre-seeded and swim mixed gender, slow to fast, as timed finals. No deck entries will be allowed. Age limits/guidelines are designated on the order of events page.

3. With submission of entries, the coach/team representative attests that all swimmers entered are registered with USA Swimming.
4. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing racing starts or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Officials: $\quad$ Teams are required to provide certified stroke and turn officials at every meet. We greatly appreciate the help and early commitment of certified officials at all sessions. Failure to provide certified officials may result in swim times not being protected. Official's uniform is white polo shirt, black pants, shorts, or skirt, white socks and black shoes.

Relays \& Relay names must be submitted on relay entry forms provided at the meet. Starting: $\quad$ Starting blocks at the deep end of the pool. Second and fourth legs of 200 meter relay events will start in water at shallow ( $3^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}$ ) end of the pool (no starting blocks).

Bull Pen: A bullpen will be provided for all 8 \& Under events only. All other swimmers shall report directly to their assigned lanes. (Event \#s 9, 10, 15, 16, 43, 44, 49, 50)

Awards: $\quad 1$ st -3 rd medals. 4th -8 th ribbons. Boys and girls swam together but scored separately.
Individual: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relays: 18-14-12-108-6-4-2
All scoring will be based on age groups; $8 \& \mathrm{U}, 9-10,11-12,13-14,15 \& \mathrm{O}$, even when swimming a combined event (i.e.13\&O event would be scored 13-14 and 15\&O).
