OSI Board Meeting

Wednesday, June 7th, 2017, 7:15pm, Conference Call

Motion to approve minutes from May 2017. M/S/P

Treasurer's Report - David Galbraith

Through some careful and quiet research (so as to not raise any eyebrows...) I have been able to determine that the OSCA and OSI financial relationship that we will formalize through our new registration accounting processes is a straight forward custodial relationship. And therefore, there is no requirement to generate a 1099 for the pass-through OSCA registration funds collected as they are not considered income to OSI. I have also identified a resource that is available to help OSCA review their current operational status. I have forwarded the contact information for this resource to Rick.

Extension has been filed for our taxes at the request of our accounting firm. They are working to finalize the return.

I am still looking for better visibility into everyone's planned workshops and convention attendance expenses for the remainder of the year. I have still not received any information of planned travel from anyone, so I do not have any information from which to update the workshop travel budget estimates. So this remains an open concern.

Update on the proposal to move some of the operating funds from the OSI checking account into a new set of UBS investment accounts: The OSI Columbia Bank main checking account currently has a balance of just over \$271K. Based on the budget forecast for the remainder of 2017, the end of year balance is estimated to be just over \$250K. I propose to work with Jeff G. to move \$100K out of the checking account and into a new set of laddered UBS investment accounts separate from the Travel Endowment accounts to hold these excess Operating Funds. These accounts would be managed by Jeff in the same manner as the Travel Fund accounts. Keeping the operating investments separate from the travel fund investment accounts will simplify the accounting of these investments. I would also like to move the OSI operating funds that were transferred into the UBS travel investment accounts in the past into these new operating funds investment accounts. The amount, however, is still in question. I will need some help with getting the detailed history of the previous

This also clearly highlights another reason why it will be better to keep the operational and travel fund investments in separate account.

Teams entering must agree to provide officials based on entries. Officials can be named the week prior to the meet. Host team is exempt from requirement.

There is a 2 year exemption for new teams and Summer League teams.

Penalty - Teams that enter and do not meet these requirements will not score or receive awards.

Discussion: Rather not penalize the swimmers. Discussion on a monetary fee of not scoring/receiving awards. Julie will be asking other LSC's to see what they are doing.
